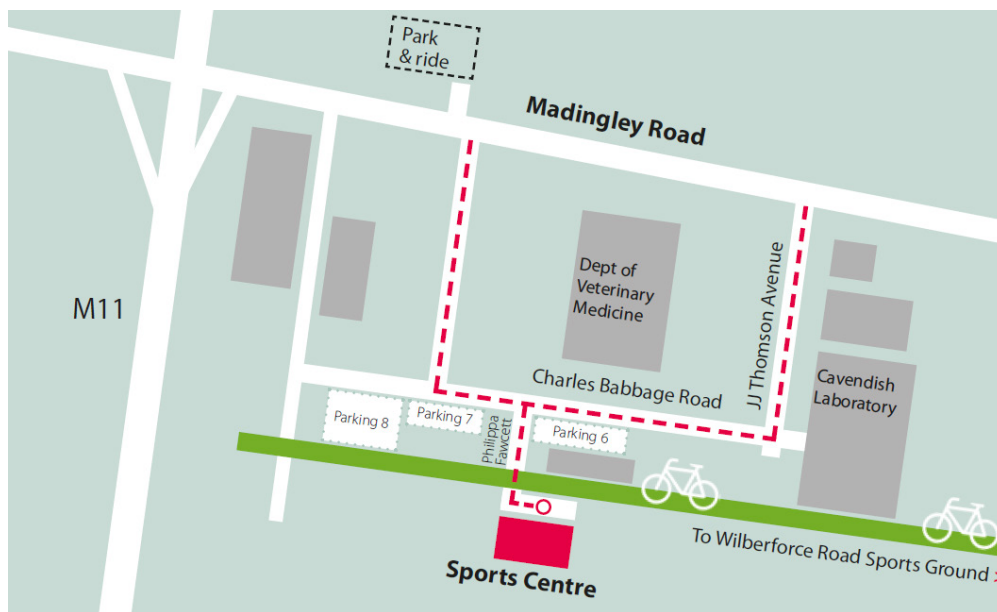
University of Cambridge Sports Centre

How to Find us

The Sports Centre is located on Philippa Fawcett Drive, Cambridge, CB3 0AS. (Type “Sports Centre and Gym, University of Cambridge” into Google Maps.)

Car Parking

Car parking is available, free of charge, a short 2 minute walk from the Sports Centre in Car Park 8 on Charles Babbage Road. Please do not drive your car down Philippa Fawcett Drive to the Sports Centre as there will be nowhere for you to park.



Bus Parking

There is no available parking for Coaches or Mini Buses at the Sports Centre. If arriving by Coach or Mini Bus, please drop off pedestrians at the sports centre and then move the bus off site immediately. We recommend parking at Madingley Park and Ride, CB3 0EU.

Blue Badge Holders

There are Accessible Parking Bays directly in front of the Sports Centre which may be used by Blue Badge holders only.

Bicycle Racks

If travelling to the sports centre by bicycle, there are multiple bicycle racks directly in front of the Sports Centre entrance.

Changing Facilities

Changing rooms, shower facilities and free lockers are available on site.

Food and Drink

There are water fountains located in reception, outside the sports hall, upstairs outside Studio 2 and in the fitness suite.

Vending machines are available to use on site with hot drinks and snacks to purchase (cash and card payment available).

There is no café facility on site, however, there are the following facilities available close by:

West Café, The Houser Forum, Charles Babbage Road, CB3 0GT – 5 minute walk.

Open Monday – Friday 8am-5pm and Saturdays 10am-3pm (Term time only.)

Sainsbury, 27 Eddington Avenue, CB3 1SE – 15 minute walk / 5 minute drive.

Open Monday-Saturday 7.30am-10pm and Sundays 10am-4pm.

Litter

We will provide multiple bins for you to use during the event. Please ensure that all rubbish is disposed of in the bins before you leave so that the event organisers and staff do not have to clear up after you.

Accidents / Emergencies

There will be qualified first aid staff on site during the event. If you have a need for first aid, please contact reception. Should an ambulance be required, the Duty Supervisor of the Sports Centre will arrange for it to be called so that they can coordinate the incident.

Should you hear the fire alarm during your visit to the Sports Centre, please make your way to the nearest fire exit immediately. Planned fire alarm drills do not take place during events.
